The Temple Terrace Community Arts Festival is a juried outdoor Fine Art and Craft Show that is produced by the Temple Terrace Arts Council, comprised of dedicated community volunteers and members from the Temple Terrace Parks and Recreation Department, GFWC Temple Terrace Woman's Club, GFWC Temple Terrace Junior Woman's Club and the Temple Terrace Chamber of Commerce.

Set in the scenic Riverhills Park, under a canopy of grandfather oaks and on the banks of the picturesque Hillsborough River in Temple Terrace, Florida, it has become known as the ideal show for artists and the community to enjoy.

Exhibitor selection is done by the Temple Terrace Arts Council. It is our desire to focus on quality as well as a wide variety of fine art and crafts. We are proud to provide a continuing avenue for the expression and appreciation of art in many forms.

We welcome your application to the 36th Annual Temple Terrace Community Arts Festival.

Festival Rules

1. Only **EXHIBITORS** displaying their *own original work* may participate. No proxy exhibitors will be allowed. No copies or commercial reproductions - this is for original, handcrafted work. Laser prints must be clearly labeled as such.
Please note: No manufactured products or commercial displays, ceramics cast from commercial molds, kits, tile, beads or novelty shell crafts, dough art, velvet paintings, decopage, plants (except as display), or foods will be allowed.
Exhibitors who feel their work qualifies as an exception may submit photos for further consideration.
2. **EXHIBITED SPACE** will be approximately 10' x 10'. Juried space may not be shared. Each exhibitor must provide *appropriate display* for outdoor exhibition and set up own display. The park remains in its natural state, so please be prepared to accept slightly imperfect elevations and natural protrusions, such as tree roots.
No electricity is available in exhibit area. Generators must be approved by the Arts Council.
No pets are allowed in exhibit area.
No ribbons from previous shows may be exhibited.
Please Note: No tent stakes allowed, all tents must be weighted down.
3. **SET UP TIME:** Friday 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Saturday 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. All exhibits must be up by 10:00 a.m. and must remain in place *both days* until 4:00 p.m.
Please Note: Due to safety concerns, absolutely no one will be allowed to set-up in exhibit area prior to 3:00 p.m. on Friday.
4. The Arts Council reserves the right to reject unsuitable work and is not responsible for damage, loss, or overnight storage.
5. No refunds will be made due to cancellation by applicant and/or Arts Council.
6. Each exhibitor is responsible for collecting Florida State sales tax and reporting to the Florida Revenue Commission.
7. The Arts Council maintains the right to review all displays and inspect all art work to insure that they are in accordance with festival rules and that the art work is as represented by photos submitted with application. Violation of the festival rules may be grounds for expulsion without a refund.

8. **Juried Fine Arts and Fine Contemporary Crafts (Award Category):** Work must have been executed by the artist within the last three years.
Fee \$125: Application and (5) photographs representative of applicant's work, including a photo of display, **MUST** be postmarked on or before October 15, 2009. Applications received after October 15 will be charged a \$10 late fee. In addition to the (5) photographs, please submit at least one image in a pdf file (600 dpi) on disc or via email to www.templeterraceartscouncil.org. This image will be used in the 2009 Arts Festival Program/Directory. **Work represented in photographs must have been executed by artist within the last three years. Applicants will be notified upon review by Arts Council for acceptance. If work is not accepted, \$115 will be refunded. A canopy is required. Award money has been increased.**
9. Crafts: Fee \$110: Application and (5) photographs representative of applicant's work, including a photo of display, **MUST** be post marked on or before October 15, 2009. Applications received after October 15 will be charged a \$10 late fee. Applicants will be notified upon review by Arts Council for acceptance. If work is not accepted, \$100 will be refunded. A Best of Craft Award has been added to this category.
10. **Public Art Purchases:** The Temple Terrace Arts Council makes an annual purchase of up to \$4,500 worth of fine art pieces for the enhancement of Public Art in the community.
11. All accepted applicants will have photos returned on Sunday.

 - *Completed application form*
 - *Self-addressed, stamped, business-size envelope*
 - *Submit at least one image in a pdf file (600 dpi) on disc or via email to www.templeterraceartscouncil.org.*
